COMMON AILMENTS

- Influenza
- Evaluation of weakness
- Falls among the elderly

NEUROLOGICAL

- Vertigo

- Urinary retention

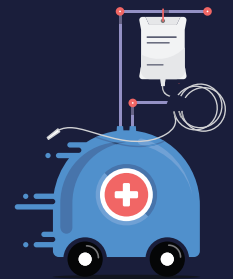
PROCEDURES PERFORMED

- IV placement
- 12 lead EKG
- Administer IV fluids, medications and antibiotics
- Laceration repair (simple to complex): sutures or staples
- Incision & drainage of skin lesions
- Splint injured extremities
- Advanced blood laboratory testing on-site
- Rapid infectious disease testing (flu, strep, mono)
- Catheter insertion: Foley, Coude, suprapubic
- Nasal packing and cautery
- Bronchodilator administration
- IV Medications: diuretics, steroids, antibiotics and antiemetics

When Not to Call Us

If the patient is experiencing any of the following symptoms, call 911:

- Chest pain
- Stroke symptoms: numbness or weakness on one side, difficulty speaking, swallowing or walking
- Vomiting blood
- Rectal bleeding
- Loss of consciousness
- Loss of vision
- Confusion
- Severe abdominal pain
- Intentional overdose or suicidal thoughts
- Moderate to severe shortness of breath
- Hallucinations
